### **DISCUSSION**

### 1. SAVHS Trip Proposal

Josh Dumas, a St. Anthony Village High School AP Biology teacher, presented an opportunity for his class to visit the Field Museum of Natural History in Chicago. Planned for mid-May, approximately 24 students will spend at least one full day at the museum, exploring one of the largest, most extensive, and hands on natural history museums in the world.

### 2. Community Services Transportation

Director of Community Services Wendy Webster presented information regarding an option to lease a van to provide transportation to low income families so they may attend early childhood programs. The option to have a Community Services vehicle would allow flexibility in transporting children to morning and afternoon preschool classes, opportunities for families to attend evening offerings, and allows a means of transportation for small group field trips. Additional information will be presented at the March 3<sup>rd</sup> meeting.

#### 3. 2015 - 2016 Budget / Capital 5 Year Plan

Director of Business Services Bill Menozzi presented the 2015 – 2016 General Fund Balance and reviewed the District's 5 Year Capital Plan. The budget will also be presented at the March 3<sup>rd</sup> meeting.

#### 4. TIES

Director of Business Services Bill Menozzi presented an overview of TIES fees, programs and the history with the District. TIES is an education technology collaborative. The District uses TIES for online credit card payments (Fee Pay) and for finance and payroll (HR) software.

### Superintendent Report:

Superintendent Laney mentioned an Achievement and Integration pilot program the district is exploring with Columbia Heights. The program focuses on developing critical thinking and writing skills with students in the 40 to 60 percentile, offers an 8<sup>th</sup> grade summer session and an opportunity for collaboration to enhance teacher effectiveness and innovation with the two districts.
